3. Continue to develop assessment systems that allow teachers and administrators to review and analyze data in a timely manner.

The Strategic Success Plan (SSP) is intended to guide the work of the school district. The plan is distinctly different from a strategic plan in that the SSP is designed to be a pivotal document that anchors the District's annual work and permits real time adjustments to be made by key District personnel. The SSP is not a community plan, rather it is a written plan that operationalizes the Vision and Mission of Branford Public Schools (BPS). The plan, through an ongoing review process, is designed to have overarching goal statements from which action plans are designed and implemented. The SSP should not be viewed as commencing in September and ending in June, rather the SSP is a fluid planning document which can be modified as appropriate. It is the Board's intention to have such a report made by the Superintendent of Schools and appropriate staff.

The District's first iteration of the SSP shall focus on systems development and continuous growth of students by measuring a variety of qualitative and quantitative measurements. As you read and interact with the brochure it should be evident that the school district's work is squarely focused on students, their preparation by and experiences in Branford Public Schools, so they are well positioned for success in post secondary education or career and ultimately adulthood.
