

## PEP Presentations

**Thurs., 6/14 and Fri., 6/15 - PEP presentations 2 hours each day (10 minutes for each presentation). 10AM-12PM each day.**

*Learning Target: I can clearly articulate, and demonstrate growth in a chosen topic.*

Slideshow requirements:

Check:

<b>Introduction:</b> Introduce yourself and give some background about you as a person/student.	
Explain the process of determining or figuring out what to do for your project (your initial ideas and how you narrowed down).	
Give a brief explanation of your project.	
Tell why your project is of interest to you, what drew you to the topic, and/or what is important about your topic	
<b>Beginning, Progress, Documentation:</b> Explain the first steps you took in getting started.	
Explain changes that you made along the way.	
Identify important skills, facts, and/or logistics that you learned from your research and throughout the process of completing your project.	
Include a picture or piece of documentation (notes, permission slips, letters, pictures) from your early steps.	
<b>Product:</b> Explain what you did, how you did it. Describe your final product.	
Reveal your finished product (show your visual) and describe your finished product in specific detail.	
Include pieces of documentation (pictures, video links, etc.) to show off your finished product.	

<p><b>Conclusion/Reflection:</b> Describe any changes you would make if you were to do this over.</p>	
<p>What was the most important part of the process? What was most fun? What do you hope the audience learns from your presentation?</p>	
<p>Give an opportunity for the audience to ask you questions, and be ready to answer.</p>
